READING INTERVENTION PACKAGES

Basic Reading Intervention:

Begin the path to becoming a more confident reader! LifeReader's Reading Intervention package is designed to assist struggling readers by equipping them with the tools necessary to decode words, improve fluency, and expand comprehension skills using a combination of phonics, spelling, and vocabulary words.* (beneficial to students with dyslexic tendencies)

*K-8th grade; 10 one-on-one sessions**
*More than 10 sessions may be necessary

Intervention Building Blocks:

LifeReader's Intervention Building Blocks package is a natural next step for children who have completed our Reading Intervention package. The goal is to maintain and build upon the skills they've learned in their initial sessions. For some students, this may be the appropriate starting point, depending on their existing skill level. * (beneficial to students with dyslexic tendencies)

K-12th grade; 10 one-on-one sessions

READING COMPREHENSION PACKAGE

Reading Comprehension Lab:

LifeReader's Reading Comprehension Lab is meant to enhance a student's background knowledge and expose them to integrated reading that incorporates content from other subjects like science and social studies. This practice enhances a student's ability to build knowledge, versus simply memorizing facts to pass a test. Throughout these sessions, students will also be exposed to expanded vocabulary in an effort to enhance their word usage.

3rd-12th grade; 10 one-on-one sessions

WRITING PACKAGES

Writing Lab:

Through LifeReader's Writing Lab package, your child will learn how to brainstorm their ideas through guided writing and develop tools needed to compose their thoughts more clearly. This package consists of a one-hour weekly writing lab, combined with a one-hour a week reading comprehension lab.

*3rd-12th grade; 3-4 students;
10 group sessions*

Creative Writing:

Strong writers are often more successful in all aspects of life. LifeReader's Creative Writing package is meant to help students develop their creative writing skills by crafting their own blog. Students will also be given the opportunity to submit their work in multiple writing contests and create a personal portfolio.

*8th-12th grade; Minimum of 3 students;
10 group sessions*

Handwriting Sessions:

The art of handwriting is no longer taught in school at the deep level it once was. LifeReader's Handwriting Sessions package is designed to help students hone their skills and emphasize the proper placement of letters for the purposes of making their writing more legible. This package also uses activities and exercises that incorporate math, social studies, science, and English language arts!

1st-3rd grade; 10 one-on-one sessions

ENRICHMENT OPTIONS

Socratic Seminars:

Socratic Seminars acknowledge the highly social nature of learning while advocating for a student-centered approach. Students who participate in these sessions will engage in formal text-based discussions prompted by open-ended questions from the instructor. Through this exercise, students will learn how to articulate their own thoughts, while listening to the thoughts and perspectives of their peers who are processing and dissecting the same material. As a result, students learn to work cooperatively with a group, establish the confidence to express their thoughts, build critical thinking skills, and develop a stronger spirit of civility from hearing the perspective of their peers who may have differing opinions.

9th-12th grade; 4-5 students; Weekly drop-in

Book Club:

Even as adults, connecting with others through the shared love of reading can provide a lot of joy. LifeReader's Book Club will give your child the opportunity to read a novel with their peers and have in-depth conversations about what they've read.

*5th-8th grade; Group;
Meets every other week*
